WHAT IS MARIN OAKS?

Marin Oaks is a Model Continuation School for the state of California. It has been accredited through Western Association of Schools and Colleges, receiving the highest honors of a six-year clear accreditation, expiring on June 30, 2023.

Marin Oaks prides itself in providing educational alternatives to help students fulfill their high school graduation requirements and earn a high school diploma. The program is designed to not only assist students in earning a high school diploma, but also to provide them opportunities for personal growth, and the development of vocational and academic skills to help assist students to find success in post-secondary education.

Receiving a diploma from Marin Oaks is equivalent to a traditional high school diploma, such as Novato High School or San Marin High School.

Class Hours: 9:00 a.m. – 1:52 p.m.

Enrichment Class Hours: 8:17 – 8:57 a.m. / 1:52 – 3:00 p.m.

Marin Oaks offers a variety of enrichment courses before and after school, including drama, cooking, gardening, life skills, and work experience.

Marin Oaks offers intervention support including, 1:1 tutoring; free counseling; and workshop courses within the school day to help ensure students pass the CAHSEE.

WHAT ARE THE STEPS TO ENROLL?

1. Students interested in Marin Oaks must talk with their counselor and ask for a referral.
2. Students need to have satisfactory attendance and minimal discipline infractions.
3. Parent(s)/Guardian(s) and the interested student must complete a written portion on the referral.
4. Once a referral has been sent to Marin Oaks, the school will contact the student for an intake interview.
5. Students are enrolled four times a year: August, October, January, and March. Seniors take priority.
